CHARLES PROBANDT, PRESIDENT OF FBA, CONTINUES WITH "POINTS TO PONDER" ON CATTLEMAN'S FUTURE

The mountainman is no longer functioning as he did in the past century; he is gone, a legend of the old West. Will we, the cattlemen of today, survive to live and function in the future as we now do? I don't think we have a chance. Sure, we could if a series of economic events, purely by accident, should occur during the coming years.

I have seriously considered the possibility of what would happen if all of us who are now producing beef were to abandon our profession, for whatever reason. Who would take over our ranches, farms, and feed lots? Let us assume that the price of land continues to increase and the only people who can afford to buy land are the professional individuals who know little about cattle production. Due to their lack of knowledge and experience, they would produce only about 70% of the current output of beef. What would happen to the price they received for their product? I project that beef in the supermarket would increase by 50%, maybe more. Such an increase would allow the new producers to make a reasonable profit.

Price is always affected by supply and demand. In regard to supply, only voluntary or governmental controls would be effective, but the American consumer would have to pay more for meat. Demand, on the other hand, can be expanded in many

ways. The easiest and quickest method is to increase exports. How can this be done? The only alternative is for the cattle industry to become involved in determining government policies concerning the import and export of beef. In the past, our attitude of independence has prevented us from having an impact in the policy making department in government; too few voices and too few votes.

Five years ago, the leaders of our industry gathered together and formed the National Cattleman's Association, representing all segments of our cattle industry. Many of the cattle people with whom I visit are not members of the N.C.A. They feel that the structure of the organization is wrong or they dislike an officer or member of the staff. Often, they feel removed from the group which attends the conventions and serves as spokespersons for the U.S. cattle industry.

The Foundation Beefmaster Association is currently active in the N.C.A. We have submitted a slate of committeemen who have your interest in mind and will represent you with skill, dedication, and enthusiasm. They need your support. Remember the era of the mountainman; contemplate the possible fate of the cattleman and join us as a member of the N.C.A.

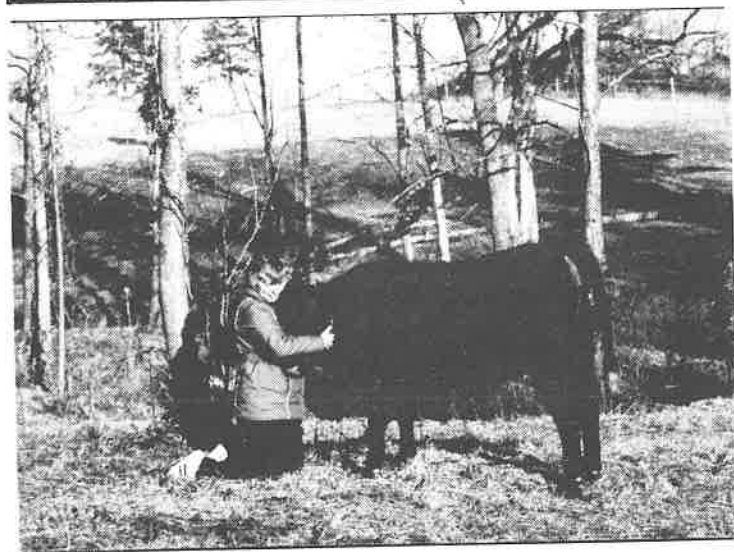

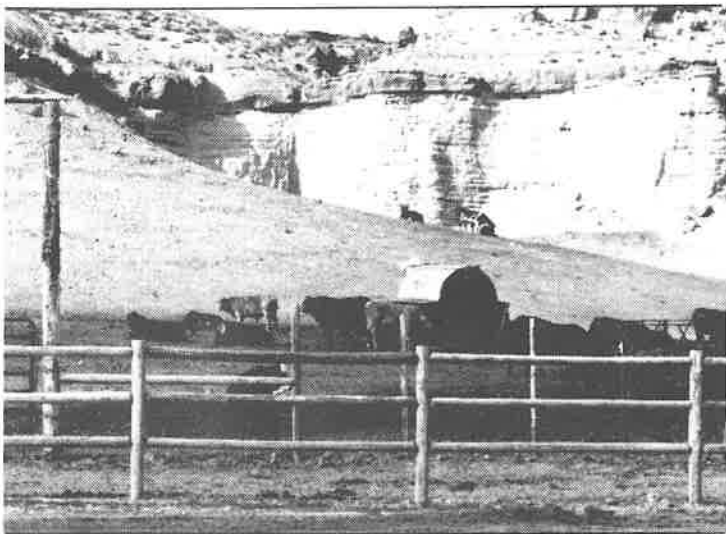
THIS IS NO BULL

SALE REPORT FROM FOUNDATION WEST BEEFMASTER BREEDERS

Just a note to let you know what went on at our recent Foundation West Beefmaster Breeders' (FWBB) bull sale and annual meeting, both of which took place on Saturday, March 24, 1984.

At the sale we averaged \$1,418.18. We had bull buyers from 5 Western states. Volume buyer was Bill McGrew, Glens Ferry, Idaho who took home 15 bulls. Second was Hank Filipinii, Battle Mountain, Nevada who bought 8 bulls in the sale.

The highest selling yearling in the sale was a Ralph Wheatley Broken Bar Beefmaster bull who sold for \$3,100 to our own FBA & FWBB member, Ernest Patjens, The Dalles, Oregon. Second highest selling bull was also from Ralph's herd, and sold to Bill McGrew for \$2,100.

We were proud to have FBA President Charles Probandt present for both the sale and at the annual meeting.

In the meeting, elections were held to fill the expired term of our former FWBB President Melvin Anderson. Dean Gustafson, West Jordan, Utah, was elected as the new director.

ISA CATTLE COMPANY SALE RESULTS

Ninety-nine Beefmaster bulls sold for an average of \$1,765 per head at the Isa Cattle Co. March 17, 1984 production sale conducted at Producers' Livestock Auction Co. by auctioneer, Ron Ball, of Brush, Colorado.

The 99 bulls, raised by seven members of the Foundation Beefmaster Association, brought a total of \$173,800.

The top selling bull, raised by Mackey McEntire of Big M Beefmasters at Sterling City, brought \$5,200. Second highest selling bull, raised by Andy Smith of Water Valley, brought \$4,500.

Isa Cattle Co. purchased the bulls as calves from the seven Beefmaster breeders. The bulls averaged 17 months of age. Producers with bulls in the sale included McEntire, Smith, Jack Williams of San Angelo, L.G. Hargis, Jr. of Oklahoma, Henry Martinez of Amarillo, Charles M. Probandt of Sterling City, and Don Fields and Troy Wimberly of Robert Lee.

Top volume buyer was Grassy Island Ranches of Okeechobee, Florida paying \$30,400 for 17 head.

Other volume buyers were Concho Livestock Co. of San Angelo, 15 head; Riley West Ranch of Tuscon, Arizona, 10 head; Barlite Ranches of Marfa, 9 head; Canyon Blanco Ranches of Stanley, New Mexico, 7 head; W. A. Oatman of Maryneal, 6 head; John Black of El Paso, 4 head; Garrett Ranches of Clovis, New Mexico, 3 head; and Prewit Ranch of Pecos, 2 head; Jack Williams of San Angelo, 2 head; Lloyd L. Davis of Brackettville, 3 head; I. W. Terry of Sterling City, 2 head; and Richard Hintergardt of Gruver, 2 head.

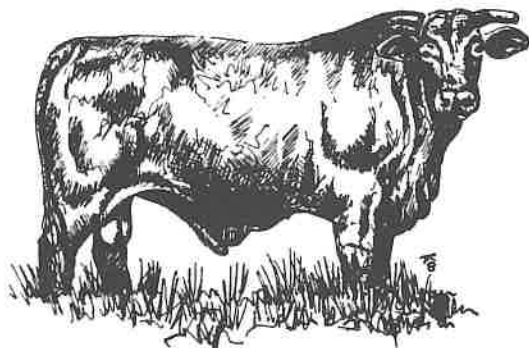
