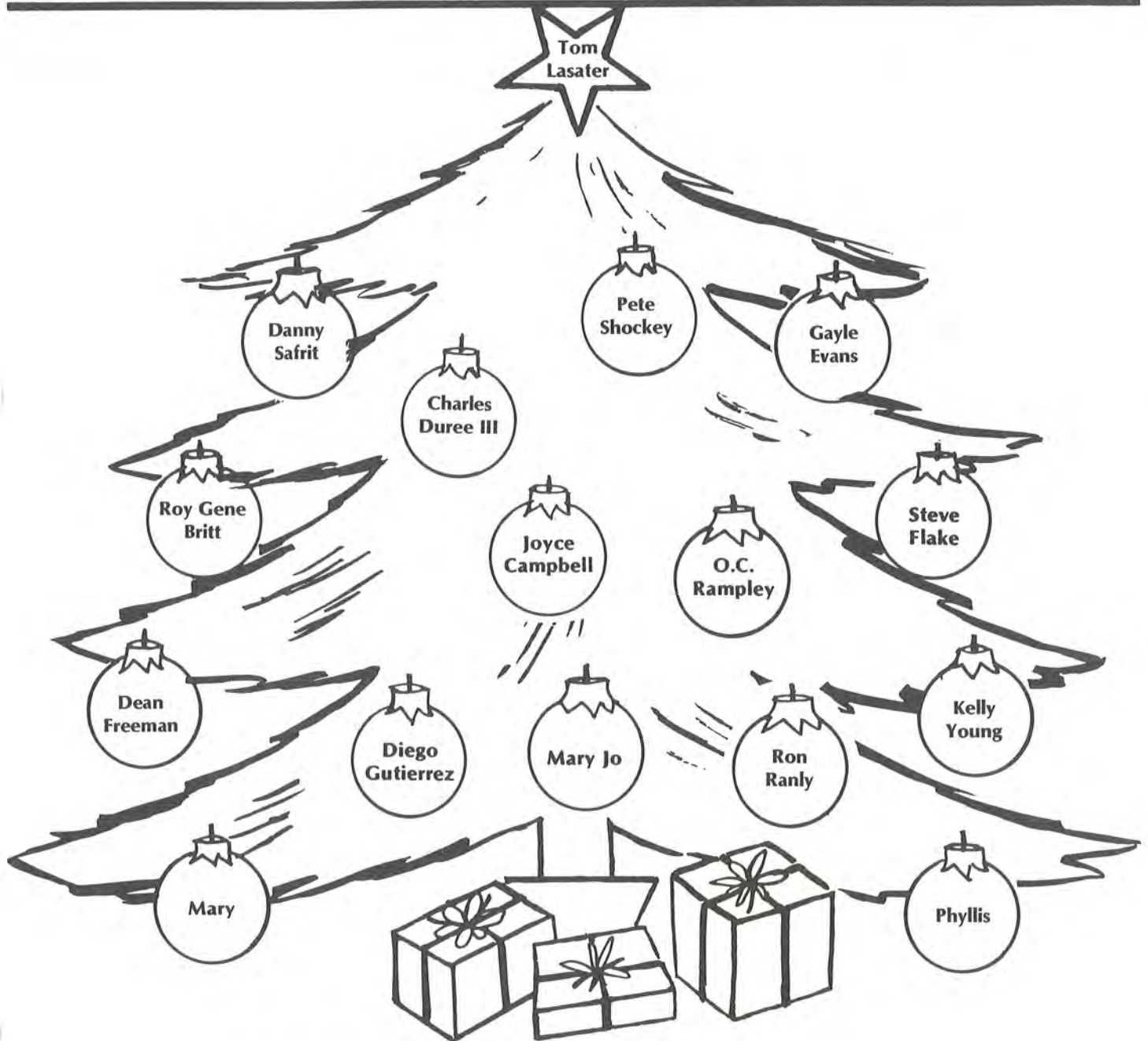

## Isa Bulls go to Five States and Mexico

Buyers came from all points of the compass to Producers Auction at San Angelo, Texas, for the 16th Isa Cattle Company Sale, Saturday, October 1 and watched 288 Beefmaster bulls average \$1,875. Total gross on the sale was \$540,200.

The emphasis was on volume buyers as 10 ranches bought 10 bulls or more from an offering of yearling and two-year-old bulls. The 183 two-year-old bulls brought an average of \$2,128 with the high selling bull going for \$5,000 to Dr. Bill Broussard of Melbourne, Florida. The two-year-olds grossed \$389,450.

There were 105 yearling Beefmaster bulls in the sale which averaged \$1,435 with the high selling yearling bringing \$3,100. Gross on yearlings was \$150,750.

Volume buyer in the sale was William G. Carey of Throckmorton, Texas, with a purchase of 27 head for \$56,100.

# FOUNDATION BEEFMASTER ASSOCIATION'S 17th ANNUAL CONVENTION HELD IN LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS

The business of the convention got underway with committee meetings on Thursday, November 3rd. Once again this year, these meetings found all of the committee members as well as a number of non-committee members taking an active role in the discussion.

A special "Meet the Candidates" reception was held on the evening of the 4th. Hors d'oeuvres were served and all of the candidates running for board positions were introduced. In addition to meeting the candidates, this traditional gathering creates a great opportunity for all of the members to visit with other purebred FBA Beefmaster breeders.

The general membership meeting was called to order by President Dr. William Broussard, Saturday morning, November 5th. Following adoption of the minutes from the previous meeting, various committee reports were given. President Broussard in his opening remarks, spoke of another good year for FBA. In particular, he pointed out the continued success of the satellite program, in particular the field days and sales conducted by the satellites.

In her report, FBA executive Secretary Mary Wilkinson, echoed Dr. Broussard's feeling regarding the success of the preceding year. Mary reported that the total number of both FBA members and cattle are currently at an all time high.

Committee reports were given by Dean Stephens, Finance; Gale Evans, Membership; Bev Sparrowk, Public Relations; and Oran Tracy, Satellites. In addition to the annual membership awards, Gale Evans also presented a special award in recognition for outstanding promotion of the Beefmaster breed and the Association to both Walter Truitt and Gary Frenzel.

Individual satellite reports were given on the Heart of America, Sierra Pacific, Southern, Arkansas, Border, Central Texas, Intermountain, Panhandle and South West Beefmaster Breeder satellites. In addition to the reports, the satellites also held a special meeting on Thursday evening, November 3rd. The meeting, which was described as a seminar on how to conduct seminars, was well attended with many people taking an active part in the discussions. Luane Schroeder of the Arkansas Beefmaster Breeders satellite served as group leader for the meeting.

On Saturday, the 5th, conventioners conducted the business of the meeting and participated in two special presentations. The first of these presentations was a talk given by Dr. William Oliver. Dr. Oliver received his Ph.D. in Animal Science from Texas A & M University. He spent 22 years as a high school teacher of Vocational Agriculture and then joined the staff of Louisiana State University's Hill Farm Research Station as Assistant Professor of Animal Science. He spent two years as a member of the Ford Foundation team assigned to assist in developing a land grant type college of agriculture at the University of Aleppo in Aleppo, Syria. Dr. Oliver also received a special award

of outstanding service to American Agriculture from Ford Motor Co. Dr. Oliver recently retired from the position of professor responsible for beef cattle breeding, forage-beef production, and forage utilization research.

In his presentation, Dr. Oliver stressed the need for pure-bred breeders to be cognizant of breeding traits that help the customer of the seed stock producer, the commercial cattleman, make money. In particular, Dr. Oliver felt the Brahman influence in Beefmaster cattle was particularly good. He warned those attending not to eliminate those characteristics in their individual breeding programs. Genetically, Dr. Oliver felt that there were three items that were fundamental to good cows. First was fertility, next was the ability to survive and raise her calf, and finally milk production. Naturally, breeders who follow the Foundation Beefmaster Association, or Lasater philosophy, were quick to recognize these three elements as three of the six essentials.

The second presentation was a panel discussion moderated by Dr. William Broussard of Melbourne, Florida, with Dale Lasater of Colorado Springs, Colorado, Gene Perkins from Bruneau, Idaho, Jim Gowan of Montgomery, Alabama, and Dr. Oliver as panel members.

Each of the panel members addressed certain topics during their individual portion of the presentation, and then each of the panel members accepted and answered questions from the audience. This forum proved to be extremely popular with everyone and a lot of good information was presented. Finally, after the discussion had run about an hour over the originally allotted amount of time, Dr. Broussard called the discussion to a close with the promise that there would be more panel discussions of this type at future conventions.

Just prior to the panel discussion, the order of business called for the election of new board members. Newly elected to the Board of Directors were Danny Safrit, North State Beefmasters, Concord, North Carolina; Pete Shockey, Shockey Beefmasters, Alamogordo, New Mexico; Kelly Young, Double Spur Beefmasters, St. Johns, Arizona, and Dean Freeman, Flying F Beefmasters, Oregon, Missouri.

The four new members replace four outgoing board members, Dr. William Broussard, Melbourne, Florida, immediate past president; Dean Stephens, Salt Lake City, Utah; Dick Springs, Adrian, Oregon, and Bev Sparrowk, Clements, California.

Following the general membership meeting, the new board held their first meeting and elected officers for 1989. Steve Flake, F-Bar Cattle Company, Snowflake, Arizona, was elected as the new president of the Association. Other elected officers are, Gayle Evans, Evans Beefmasters, Park City, Utah, Vice President; Joyce

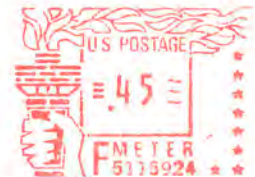
