# FOUNDATION FACTS

The following article is comprised of notes taken by Bev Sparrowk at the recent Seedstock Council during a meeting at NCA Convention in Florida.

The name of the NCA Purebred Council has been changed to NCA Seedstock Council. The meetings are open to all NCA members.

## ANIMAL PATENTS

After much discussion and a recommendation from the sub committee set up to study this issue - the Seedstock Council voted to draft a resolution stating the following:

The NCA shall support research and shall support the patenting of the process involved in genetic alteration. But the NCA shall not support the patenting of individual animals that are a result of the process.

There was much discussion on the subject of carcass data collections. The orange tag system doesn't usually work because the packers will not take the time for inspection and data collection. Alternatives need to be explored and input would be appreciated.

## BLUE TONGUE

Requirements for importation of cattle to Canada have been somewhat relaxed. I have details if anyone would like them.

Canadian Blue Tongue Policies:

1. Recognize high, medium and low instance states.
  - a. Cattle from low instance states will be accepted year around.
  - b. Cattle from medium instance states will be accepted during vector - free season with one negative test.
  - c. Medium instance states during vector season and high instance states year around - cattle must have two negative tests at least thirty days apart to be eligible.
2. **Reactors** must be removed and tested thirty days later.
3. Breeding cattle must be free of the disease and the antibody.
4. Feeder cattle must be disease free year around and antibody free during vector season.

The council has written a resolution opposing licensing restrictions on embryo transfer procedure and practitioners. (Some states are trying to pass legislation whereby only licensed veterinarians could perform embryo transfers.)

## GENETIC EVALUATION FOR BEEF CARCASS ATTRIBUTES

Colo. State University, Cornell University; Iowa State; University of Georgia - Dr. Larry Benyshek

The purpose of this project is to establish model development and computer applications for implementation of national standards for genetic evaluation for carcass traits.

One of the main concerns is - as we select more for desirable carcass traits how do we affect other desirable traits such as fertility, milking ability, etc.?

## TAX REFORM

We should contact our congressmen and senators to seek the repeal of the tax law that will eliminate the capitalization of heifers.

## NCA PROPOSED CONSIST STUDY

1. Define the consist of carcasses currently in the slaughter mix.
  - a. Carcass weight
  - b. Fat cover
  - c. Marbling score
  - d. Yield of trimmed retail cuts
2. Define the genotype consist of the US beef cow herd this will identify the factory responsible for producing the carcasses discussed above.
3. Project market share for beef by quality, grade, etc.
4. Define changes necessary to align future production.
5. Define expectations of various breeding and management practices in achieving projected carcass mix.
  - a. Tailor to regional environmental differences.
  - b. Consider existing cow herd genotypes.

## BEEF "ON" FORAGE BEEFMASTER BULL TEST

Dear Cattleman,

Consignors and sponsors of the Second Annual Beef "ON" Forage, Beefmaster Bull Test, will be hosting a Field Day, May 21, 11:00 A.M. at the Clifton Marek Ranch. The 52 bulls are consigned by members of the Central Texas Beefmaster Breeders (Satellite of the Foundation Beefmaster Association). These bulls are being tested under the guidelines of the Texas Forage and Grassland Council Bull Development Program.

The purpose of the test is to identify those bulls having a superior genetic ability to convert forages to beef by comparing contemporaries within an age and breed group in a uniform grazing environment. Consumer-wise, the trend is for leaner beef, so the feedlot period is being shortened, which means a calf going to slaughter is going to spend 75 to 85 percent of its life on pasture. With average daily gain about 35 percent heritable, cattlemen will benefit by being able to purchase potential sires that have been developed under range conditions similar to their farm and ranch. The 300 day development program will consist of winter phase and summer phase with bull's weights being taken every 28 days during the development period.

Currently the bulls average 16 months of age and are within 90 days of age. The 52 bulls are averaging 3.42 lbs. a day gain for the first 112 days! An October 22, 1988 Sale at Brenham, Texas is being planned and each bull will sell with a complete performance evaluation to include: adjusted 205 w.w., gain wts., weight per day of age, and scrotal circumference.

Join us May 21 for a free B.B.Q. lunch, door prizes, speakers, refreshments, pasture tour and **inspection** of the Beefmaster Bulls. Ultrasonic measurements of the bull's Rib Eye area is being planned and this data will also be available. The ranch is located on F.M. 3403, 1/2 mile off Hwy 77, three miles south of Lexington. If you are unable to attend, a video tape of the bulls will be available to prospective buyers and interested parties.
