Lasater Ranch Ships 90 Beefmasters Bulls

The Lasater Ranch, Matheson, has completed the delivery of 90 yearling Lasater Beefmaster bulls under its 39th annual Lasater Beefmaster Plan Contract.

In addition, the ranch delivered 53 bred cows and heifers to contract buyers.

Thirty-two buyers from eight states, Canada, South Africa and Mexico purchased these bulls and cows from the foundation herd of the Beefmaster breed. It is interesting to note over 70% of these individuals were repeat buyers.

The bulls averaged about 12 months of age and weighed approximately 850 pounds. Prices of the bulls started at \$3,200 and dropped \$25 after each selection, with the 90th bull bringing \$975.

A Message From The Membership Committee

Dear FBA Member,

As the 1988 year draws to a close it is interesting to note that the association has seen a decline in breeding certificates requests. This seems a bit strange considering we are at the present time enjoying one of the best years in the cattle business in our history. There is a great deal of enthusiasm in the business and many are so interested in getting involved that they don't request breeding certificates which, as you know, is one of the association's main source of income. I have even had some commercial buyers who told me not to worry about certificates and to keep the money. I think it behooves all of us to include the cost of certification and transfers in the sale price no matter what. It is a protection to you and a guarantee of your cattle and your integrity.

Another thought which we should keep in mind is the encouragement of FBA membership. When ever we sell an animal we should invite the buyer to join FBA and make available the necessary forms along with assisting in filling them out. This is one way you can be sure you will get credit for the new membership and the origin of the cattle. The involvement with the association will stimulate more interest and probably lead to more sales for you. While we are in this time of cattle prosperity it seems to me to be an excellent opportunity to greatly expand our membership along with our FBA income and promotions.

As a membership committee we would like to encourage each member to look over his past cattle buyers and see that each potential member you know is invited to join FBA. The enthusiasm at present is high and we have the grandest cattle and philosophy available in the history of the livestock industry.

Let's get our own enthusiasm built up to match that of our cattle and philosophy and keep the association up to the status we have always enjoyed.

In recent months the office has received several requests from members asking for a standard Foundation Beefmaster Association ranch sign.

After a great deal of research and putting the job out for bids we have selected a company who will manufacture and ship a sign direct to our members.

In order to obtain this special low price we must place orders in lots of 25 at a time. The initial order would take two weeks for the master signs and one week to personalize them. If personalized orders are received individually, a one day turn around would be typical.

All signs would have three holes drilled across the top and three across the bottom for mounting. Signs will be made of 24 gauge steel with baked enameled paint. There can be no changes or different colors. The colors being used are those used by FBA in all advertising and logos.

He gained 2.38 pounds per day on the 300-day test (ratio 111) and had a 2.37 pound weight per day of age (ratio 105). He also possessed a 15.89 square inch rib-eye.
