# FOUNDATION FACTS

## FOUNDATION BEEFMASTER ASSOCIATION 18th ANNUAL CONVENTION HELD IN MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA

Nothing, not even the San Francisco earthquake, could keep away the participants when the 18th Annual Foundation Beefmaster Association Convention was called to order recently in Monterey, California.

The business of the Convention got underway with committee meetings on Thursday, November 9th. Once again this year, these meetings found all of the committee members as well as a number of non-committee members taking an active role in the discussions.

A special "Meet the Candidates" reception was held on the evening of the 10th. Hors d'oeuvres were served and all of the candidates running for board positions were introduced. In addition to meeting the candidates, this traditional gathering provides a wonderful opportunity for all of the members to visit with other purebred FBA Beefmaster breeders.

The general membership meeting was called to order by President Steve Flake Saturday morning, November 11th. Following adoption of the minutes from the previous meeting, various committee reports were given.

In his President's Report, Steve Flake spoke of the traveling he did during the previous year. Principally, he traveled to various seminars and field days presented by the FBA satellites. He pointed out the continued success of the satellite program as well as the field days, forage tests and sales conducted by the satellites. President Flake also addressed the good that both the N.C.A. and the Beef Check-Off program are doing for the beef industry. He said, "We must continue to stress the nutritional benefits of beef," stating further that, "Beef is back as the food of choice for Americans all across the country."

In her report, FBA Executive Secretary Mary Wilkinson echoed President Flake's feelings regarding the success of both FBA and its satellite organizations. Mary reported that 1989 was a very busy year for the FBA office. In addition to the normal work load, the office also handled record numbers of certificates, transfers and renditions. She pointed out that this level of activity emphasizes the strength and growth of the association. She took a minute to thank the members of her staff for their assistance during the year.

Committee reports were given by Charles Duree - Finance, Gayle Evans - Membership, Joyce Campbell - Public Relations and Danny Safrit - Satellites. Gayle Evans presented a number of

membership awards in addition to a special membership award that was presented to Laurie Lasater of San Angelo, Texas.

Individual satellite reports were given on the Heart of America, Sierra Pacific, Southern, Arkansas, Border, Central Texas, Inter-mountain, Panhandle and South West Beefmaster Breeder satellites.

In addition to the business of the meeting, the conventioners also participated in three seminar presentations on animal health, control and forage management. These seminars were given in conjunction with a trade show conducted by Merck, Cutter, Anchor Laboratories, Hoechst Roussell, Pitman Moore, Norden Laboratories and Gallager Power Fence Co.

One of the primary duties of the convention was the election of new board members. Newly elected to the Board of Directors were Bev Sparrowk - Sparrowk Beefmasters, Clements California; James Gowan - Gowan Beefmasters, Montgomery, Alabama; Roy Schoenbeck - RS Beefmasters, Evansville, Illinois; and Stuart Dixon - Dixon Beefmasters, Matador, Texas.

The four new members replace four outgoing board members: Steve Flake, Snowflake, Arizona, immediate past president; Joyce Campbell, Wimberley, Texas; Diego Gutierrez, Laredo, Texas, and O.C. Rampley, Silverton, Texas.

Following the general membership meeting, the new board held their first meeting and elected officers for 1990. Gayle Evans - Evans Beefmasters, Park City and Enterprise, Utah was elected as the new President of the Association. This is the second time Mr. Evans has served the Association as its President. He was also elected to the office in 1981.

Other elected officers are: James Gowan - Gowan Beefmasters, Montgomery, Alabama, Vice President; Bev Sparrowk - Sparrowk Beefmasters, Clements, California, Secretary; and Charles Duree III - Duree Beefmasters, Solano, New Mexico, Treasurer.

Following the business meeting on Saturday, the entire group enjoyed a wonderful sea food theme party and dinner.

The entire convention was planned and executed by Mary Wilkinson and her staff in the FBA office, under the direction of convention co-chairpersons, Joyce Campbell, Chuck King and Bev Sparrowk. Sierra Pacific acted as the host satellite organization.
