

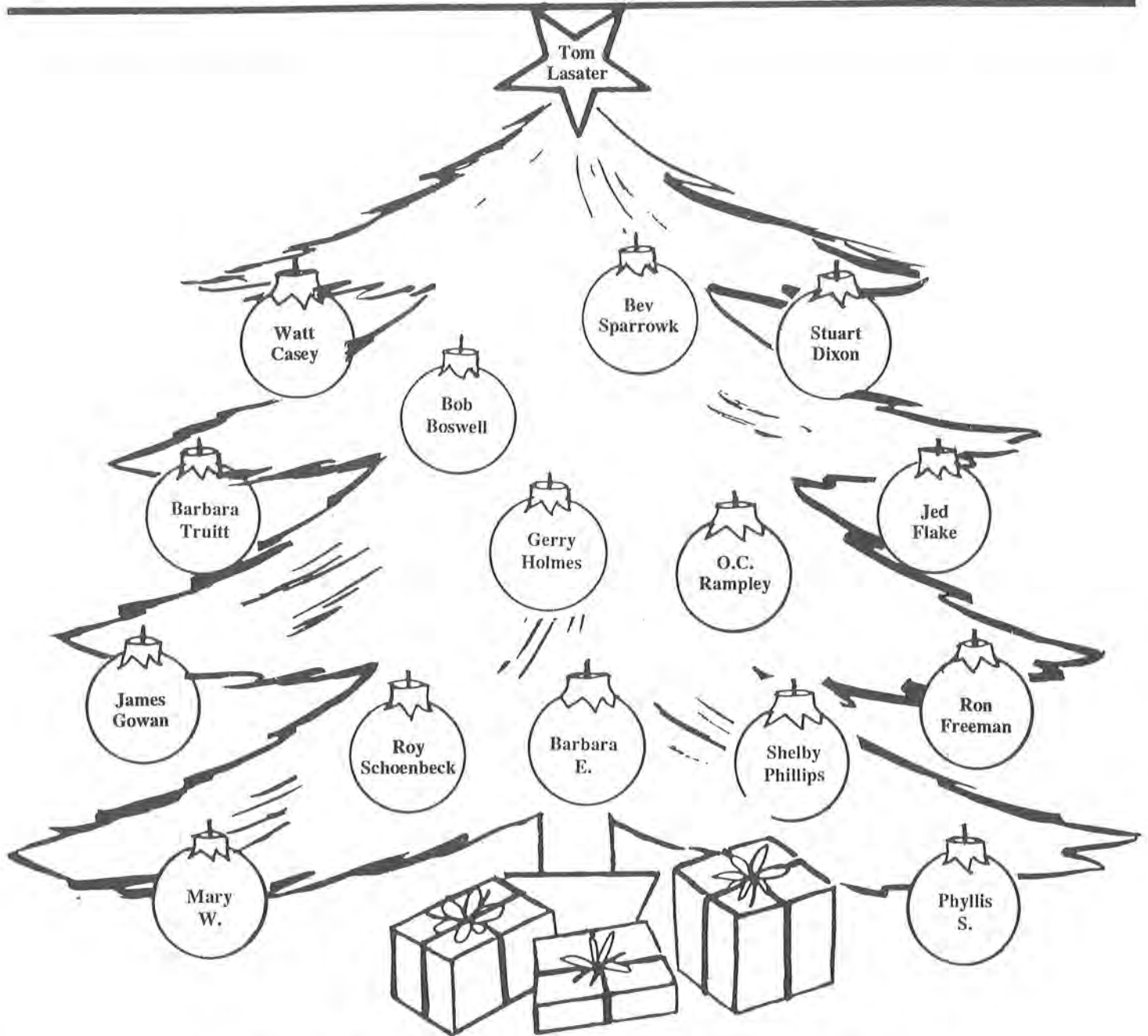

TO CERTIFY OR NOT TO CERTIFY

Between now and June 30, 1992 FBA members have the opportunity to certify any cattle that qualify for certification for \$12.

It's important that the members understand that the new fee schedule was adopted to encourage the certification of more animals but it was not meant to encourage anyone to cull less. Hopefully, members will certify animals that may someday be sold, be they older cows, heifers, or bulls of any age. It also becomes affordable for those breeders who would like to have their entire herd certified to do so.

The support of the association is the responsibility of all members. We are fortunate to belong to an association that doesn't demand much of us but we can, on a voluntary basis, contribute to the financial support of our association through our dues, inventory fees and the fees paid for certification and transfers. FBA can progress and serve the members only in direct proportion to our support.

There appears to be some confusion about certifying the older cattle now. Remember that until June 30, 1992 we are able to certify ANY animal that meets the qualifications for certification at the \$12 fee. Weaners and 11+ month old cattle can be certified for \$12 from now on, but it will cost more if you wait until they are over a year old.

All cattle born before 12-31-90 fall under the grandfather clause and can be certified at the old fee of \$35 anytime after June 30, 1992.

So if you plan to catch up on your paper work between now and June 30, send only \$12 per animal to the office.

Isn't it great that while every other operating cost is going up dramatically the cost of certification has come down!

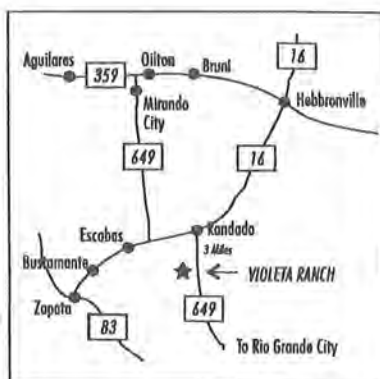

WOLF RETURNS TO APPALACHIAN MOUNTAINS

The wolf has returned or has been proposed to return to most of the United States, with the recent reintroduction of several mated pairs of red wolves to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park in the Appalachian Mountains by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services (FWS). The agency has not classified the red wolf an endangered species. It is considered a "nonessential experimental" species – a less protected class. FWS claims the wolves pose no threat to livestock as long as their natural prey, such as rabbit and squirrels, is abundant. Some biologists have questioned the reintroduction, noting that the red wolf is not a natural species but a wolf-dog-coyote hybrid. NCA supports this position. On a related note, FWS published in the November 21, 1991, *Federal Register* more than 8,000 plants and animals that it proposes classifying as endangered species. Currently there are more than 600 species on the FWS endangered and threatened species list and more than 3,000 candidate species.

CATTLEMEN SPEAK OUT ON ANIMAL CARE

Don't be surprised to hear NCA Animal Care Subcommittee Chairwoman Connie Greig of Estherville, Iowa, on your local radio station talking about animal care. Greig is featured in a radio spot produced by the Animal Industry Foundation and distributed to farm broadcasters attending the National Association of Farm Broadcasters' meeting in Kansas City last month. In the spot, Greig says, "Our folks in the city think it's a little strange, but my boys grew up learning that on our ranch, the cattle come first. The rule has always been: the cattle get fed, then you get supper." Greig goes on to emphasize that good animal care is good business. Other spots have been created for the pork, poultry and veal industries.

KIDS SURPRISINGLY SMART ABOUT NUTRITION

Youngsters know more about nutrition than one might think reports the American Dietetic Association and Food Information Council. The two organizations commissioned a Gallup Poll that found that 95 percent of children are familiar with the four food groups. That compares with 77 percent of adults. Children also understand the concepts of balance and moderation, the survey found. Some 84 percent agreed that it's best to eat small amounts of many different foods and not too much of one thing. Disturbingly, the survey also found that children, like adults, are confused about "good" foods with 85 percent agreeing that "to eat health, you should avoid all high-fat foods" and 77 percent agreeing that "you should never eat foods with large amounts of sugar." Notes ADA President Mary Abbot Hess, though the kids basically already know the big picture. Diets should be judged based on combination of foods consumed over time, not on the basis of individual food.

LOW-FAT BEEF STIRS INTEREST, CONTROVERSY

Hometown Butcher, a division of Keystone Foods Corporation, has entered the booming low-fat beef market with 92-percent fat-free product. Eight years of research produced the Hometown product which uses modified dairy solids as a binder. "Hometown Butcher – a 92-percent fat-free product–tastes as good as–or better than–regular ground beef," says Liz Wunderlich, director of sales for Hometown Butcher. The ground-beef product is available in Baltimore, Washington, D.C., and Texas Supermarkets and comes in 1-pound packages containing four 4-ounce patties and 1-pound brick packages. Meanwhile, Keystone rolls out its new product, unions are blocking ConAgra's efforts to sell its new Health Choice ground beef in both Chicago and Minneapolis, the company told the Omaha World-Herald. Contracts between union meatcutters and grocery chains don't allow pre-packaged beef to be sold in supermarkets located in those cities. Healthy Choice, a 96-percent fat-free product that uses an oat-based fat substitute, is available in other cities around the country.
