

## Another Year of Profits Expected in Cattle Business

The year 1991 looks like another pretty good year for the cattle business. Based on current indicators, the cattle industry in total should experience its fifth consecutive year of profitability, Cattle-Fax analysts said today.

Partly because of continued strong feeder cattle prices, cattle feeders are expected to see their margins narrow. Efficient cow-calf operators should have relatively good profits this year, the analysts said. Comments on the industry's profit outlook were presented at the annual Cattle-Fax outlook session at the 1991 convention of the National Cattlemen's Assn. Cattle-Fax is a cattle market information, analysis and research service.

The analysts identified and commented on 10 major factors that will affect industry profitability in 1991. Presenting the information were Topper Thorpe, general manager of Cattle-Fax; Tommy Beall, director of market research; Randy Blach, director of market analysis, and Tom Brink, research analyst. The presentation covered basic supply, demand and other factors.

On average, 1991 fed cattle prices are now expected to be up slightly from 1990 levels. Feeder cattle and calf prices will Je steady to slightly higher. Costs, including feed costs, are expected to be stable.

Thorpe emphasized that the 1991 situation is by no means certain. Because of international problems and other factors, there currently is considerable uncertainty in the market.

The 10 factors which the analysts said would affect profitability are: Cattle numbers and beef supplies; "currentness" in fed cattle marketings; demand for beef; beef exports; weather; production costs; economic developments; financing; competing meat supplies; and new products and innovations.

New products and innovations. Among factors which can affect meat supplies and demand in 1991 are the development of low-fat ground beef; continuing criticism of beef for health reasons; producer and company efforts to move from a strictly commodity business to more of a branded product, value-added business; and increased emphasis on food safety.

Most cattle operators have made money most of the time during the past four years. Thorpe said that there should continue to be profit opportunities for operators in all segments of the business in 1991, although feeders, whose margins have narrowed recently, could see further tightening of margins in 1991.

Expansion of breeding herds is expected to remain slow, averaging only 1 to $11 / 2 \%$ per year during the next few years. This means that average per capita beef supplies will remain in the $68-70 \mathrm{lb}$. (retail weight) range. One factor limiting herd expansion has been a need to pay off previous debt. Another has been high cattle prices, causing producers to sell heifers for feeding rather than hold them for breeding. Poor pasture and range conditions in some areas have been a factor, too.

Thorpe said he expects fed cattle prices to be more volatile in 1991 than in 1990. During the past year, the spread Jetween high and low Choice fed steer prices was approximately $\$ 8$, compared to a typical range of $\$ 12-13$ during a year: (There always is much more variation in prices within a year - because of seasonal and other changes in supply and demand - than there is in average prices between years.)

## Southern Bull-Test Update

Twenty-seven bulls on the Southern Beefmaster Breeders Bull Forage Test completed their third weigh period January 25 . After 84 days the bulls had posted an average gain of 2.10 pounds per day with the top ten bulls averaging 2.79 pounds per day.

These bulls will sell April 13, 1991 in the South Mississippi Forage Test Sale at Tylertown, Mississippi. In addition to average daily gain on ryegrass the bulls will have additional information including: 205 day weights, weights per day of age, frame scores, pelvic area, rib-eye and back fat measures and scrotal circumferences. This winter point-ofpurchase program, "Easy To Fix: The Skinniest Six," will provide retailers with materials and other marketing and promotional items that can be used as a tie-in with National Meat Month activities.

More than 27,000 stores are expected to participate in this marketing event which will promote the skinniest six cuts round tip, top round, tenderloin, top loin, eye round and top sirloin. These skinniest six cuts all qualify for the "20/200" symbol, which means they can be cooked in 20 minutes or less and have fewer than 200 calories per 3-ounce, cooked serving.

This promotion is also supplemented by national print advertising and the third-round flight of beef checkoff-funded television advertising which will debut the new Jupiter, Fla., spot.
