Mary, who celebrated her 10th anniversary with FBA at this convention, reported that every year seems to be a little busier than its predecessor. Pete Shockey, Chairman of the membership committee, presented a number of membership awards in addition to a first place membership award that was presented to Laurie Lasater of San Angelo, Texas.

This year's convention featured two fine speakers. The first, Mr. Dean Norton, an ex-Vice President of the Tennessee Cattleman's Association, was the featured speaker at the Saturday luncheon. Mr. Norton re-iterated a theme that was raised several times during the meetings, the potential threat to cattlemen from the radical environmentalists and animal right activist. Mr. Norton mixed a good deal of humor with a strong

Colorado not only played host to the 1991 National Beef Cook-Off, but is also home to the winner, Sandy Collins of Wheat Ridge, Colorado. Her entry won her the grand prize "Best of Beef" title and \$15,000. A total of \$35,500 in prize money was awarded to 13 winners.

Collins' recipe, "Spanish Steak Roll with Sauteed Vegetables" reflects the life-style trends of '90s cooking by incorporating healthful eating and quick cooking into a fresh-tasting, convenient recipe. This 232 calorie dish can be prepared in 29-30 minutes and will be a perfect addition to the traditional family meal. As the Indoor Category winner, Collins also received a top-of-the-line TAPPAN® range.

A real Southwestern style "Chile Pepper Steak with Salsa Fresca" won the Outdoor Category for Robin Hyde, Lincoln, Nebraska. The Upper Plains Region winner won a cash prize of \$5,000 and a year's supply of charcoal and deluxe grilling equipment from KINGSFORD®. This grilled recipe, utilizing boneless beef chuck eye steaks, is marinated and seasoned with chile powder and crushed red pepper pods.

Joyce Lee Sproul, Bath, Maine representing the New England Region, created a unique hand-held salad in a crusty roll. "Beef Salad Gondolas" helped Sproul win a cash prize of \$5,000 and top-of-the-line TAPPAN® microwave oven. This recipe uses top sirloin steak which cooks to perfection in 8-10 minutes in the microwave.

"Judging this year's recipes was a challenge," said chief judge Margaret Happel, food and nutrition editor, *Redbook* magazine. "Contestants have really concentrated on healthy, fresh foods and ethnic recipes continued to be popular. Consumers are increasing in sophistication and beef will fulfill their requirements."

Happel was assisted by nine other noted food professionals: Elizabeth Alston, food editor, *Woman's Day* magazine; Janice Denham, food editor, *Suburban Journals*, St. Louis; Karen Kangas Dwyer, cookbook author and host of *Good Morning Omaha*; Katherine Eakin, editor *Cooking Light* magazine, Birmingham, AL; Abby Mandel, cookbook author and contributing editor for *Bon Appetit* and the *Chicago Tribune*; Marty Meitus, food editor for *Rocky Mountain News* of Denver; John Shoup, executive producer of *Great Chefs Television Productions*, New Orleans; Sue Zelickson, cookbook author and host of WCCO AM 830 radio talk show *Food Finds*, Minneapolis; and Gloria Glycer, food editor, The Sacramento Unions.

Spanish Steak Roll w/Sauteed Vegetables

- 1-1/2 lb. boneless beef top sirloin steak cut 1" thick
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder, divided
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 2 teaspoons vegetable oil, divided
- 1 teaspoon of butter
- 3/4 teaspoon salt, divided
- 1 each red and green bell pepper cut lengthwise into thin strips
- 1 small white onion, thinly sliced
- 1 cup sliced fresh mushrooms
- 1/3 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/4 teaspoon chili powder
- 1 tablespoon dairy sour cream
- 1 can (4 oz.) chopped green chilies, drained

Pound boneless beef top sirloin steak to about 1/4" thickness. Sprinkle with 1/2t. garlic powder and pepper. Heat 1 t. oil and butter in 12-inch heavy frying pan over medium high heat until hot. Panfry steaks 5-7 minutes for medium-rare (150°) or to desired doneness, turning once. Remove steak to heated platter; sprinkle with 1/2 t. salt. Keep warm. Add remaining 1 t. oil to frying pan. Add red and green peppers, onion, mushrooms and walnuts. Cook 2 min. stirring frequently. Add remaining 1/2 t. garlic powder, 1/4t. salt and chili powder, continue cooking 2 min., stirring frequently. Spread steak w/sour cream; top with chilies. Starting at long side, roll up steak jelly-roll fashion; secure with 6 wooden picks. Spoon vegetables around steak roll; garnish w/lemon slices and cilantro sprigs. To serve carve steak roll between wooden picks. 6 servings.

Later in the day, Mr. Bruce Berven, Executive Director of the N.C.A.'s Beef Promotion and Research Board delivered an excellent presentation on the Beef Check-off program's advertising and public relations efforts even more effective.

One of the primary duties of the convention was the election of new board members. Newly elected Directors are Bob Boswell, Gorman, Texas; Shelby Phillips III, Deming, New Mexico; Barbara Truitt, Sheldon, Missouri; and Gerry Holmes, Falkville, Alabama.

Following the general membership meeting, the new board held their first meeting and elected officers for the coming year. Bev Sparrowk, Clements, California was elected as President.

In electing Mrs. Sparrowk President, the association broke some pretty big barriers and made important history. Mrs.

Sparrowk is the first lady, in the history of the association, to serve as its President. In fact, Bev is the first lady in the nation to be elected as president of any national purebred breed association. Joann Smith was elected as president of the National Cattlemen's Association in 1985, but no United States breed association has ever been headed by a lady.

Other elected officers are O.C. Rampley, Silverton, Texas, Vice President; Gerry Holmes, Falkville, Alabama, Secretary; and Jed Flake, Snowflake, AZ, Treasurer.

Following the business meeting on Saturday, the entire convention attended a dinner cruise and show on the General Jackson Show Boat, an authentic, steam, paddle-wheel boat. The dinner was great and the show included an outstanding live musical, and a ventriloquist who ended up featuring two FBA members in his act. Both Nancy Farthing and Tim Caldwell played in an important role in the ventriloquist's hilarious performance.

BEEF "ON" FORAGE BEEFMASTER BULL SALE

The Central Texas Beefmaster Breeders hosted their Fifth Annual Beef "On" Forage Bull Sale, Saturday, October 19, in Brenham, Texas. Buyers from Texas, Oklahoma, Mississippi, Missouri and Louisiana attended the sale which featured Foundation bred bulls which had been forage tested as a group under the guidelines of the Texas Forage and Grassland Council, Bull Development program for the past 300 days.

44 buyers paid \$131,900 for 76 lots to average \$1,735. Volume buyer of the sale was Robert Greshaw, Centerville, Texas who

purchased 6 bulls for \$13,700. Salt Creek Beefmasters from Robert Lee, Texas bid \$4,100 for the high selling bull which was consigned by Frenzel Beefmasters, Temple, Texas. Second high selling bull was consigned by Marek Beefmasters, Ledbetter, Texas and sold to Buster Beefmasters, Oologah, Oklahoma for \$3,600.
