| 2 cups butter | 5 cups blended oatmeal |
| 2 cups white sugar | 1 teaspoon salt |
| 2 cups brown sugar | 2 teaspoons baking powder |
| 4 eggs | 2 teaspoons baking soda |
| 2 teaspoons vanilla | 24 oz. chocolate chips |
| 4 cups flour | 1 - 8 oz. grated Hershey Bar |
| 3 cups nuts | |

(To blend oatmeal: measure & blend in blender to a fine powder.)

Cream butter and both sugars, add eggs and vanilla. Mix together with flour, oatmeal, salt, baking powder and baking soda. Add chips, grated Hershey Bar and nuts. Roll into balls and place 2" apart on cookie sheet. Bake for 6 minutes at 375°. Makes 112 cookies, but recipe can be halved or quartered.

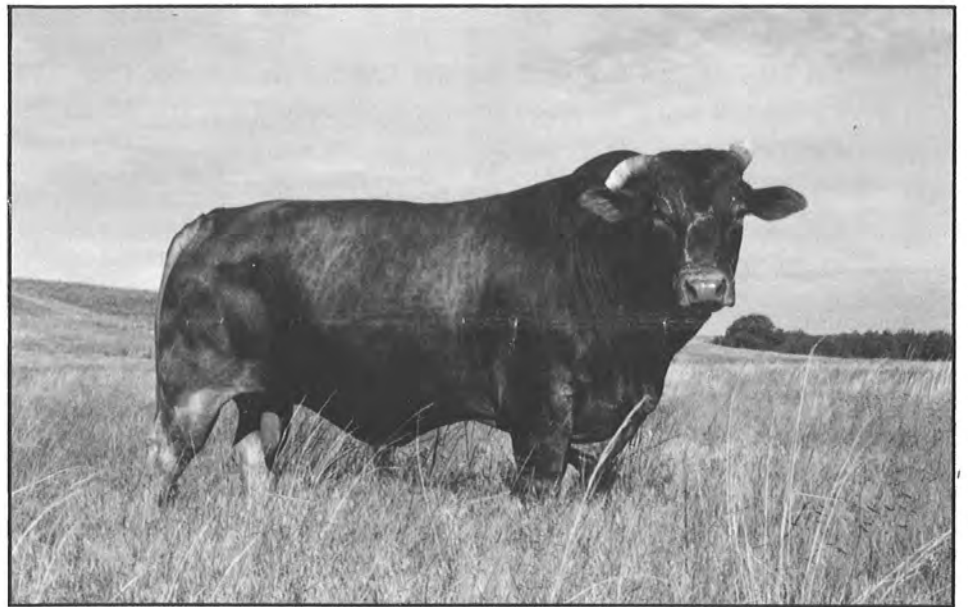

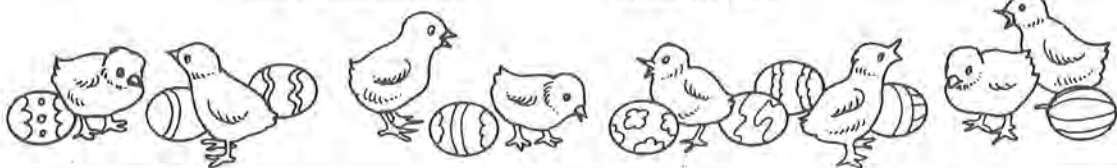


