JUST "RAMBLIN'S"

I have often wondered what a Beefmaster cow would be like if Tom Lasater had started with three other beef breeds, all other circumstances being the same.

Following the same management and culling practices, looking for the "six essentials", and knowing what he wanted in a cow, I'll bet he would have developed very nearly the same thing we have today . . . so, the "breed becomes less important than the management practices. Many in the beef industry feel there are less differences between "good cattle" of different breeds than there are differences within a breed. In the real estate business, the three most important keys to success are "location, location, location". Perhaps, in the cattle business, they are "management, management, management".

. . . EPD's? Being able to assign numerical values to animals for comparison purposes would be a great management tool. I think everyone would agree with that.

However, a "tool" that is inaccurate or unreliable is worse than no "tool" at all. Most "experts" agree EPD's are only 25 to 30% accurate, and they do not apply at all when crossing between breeds.

I think most "cattlemen" can be more accurate than that if they would only follow the management practices of the Tom Lasater philosophy and manage for the "six essentials".

. . . Honesty and Integrity. Honest cattlemen produce good, honest cattle. Integrity in cattle dealings help develop a reputation as a good breeder. **Your** reputation sells **your** cattle! Integrity, Integrity, and Integrity.

BEEF "ON" FORAGE BEEFMASTER BULL TEST

The Central Texas Beefmaster Breeders (Satellite members of the Foundation Beefmaster Association) are conducting their Eighth annual BEEF "ON" FORAGE Beefmaster Bull Test. On November 13, 1993, 30 consignors delivered 145 bulls to the Bull Test Facility located on the Clifton Marek Ranch at Lexington, Texas. The bulls delivered average 10 months of age are within 90 days of age. They are being tested under the guidelines of the Texas Forage and Grassland Council Forage Bull Development Program. They represent the largest single breed group of forage tested bulls in Texas and possibly the nation.

The purpose of this test is to identify those bulls having superior genetic ability to convert forages to beef by comparing contemporaries within an age and breed group in a uniform grazing environment. The 300 day develop-

ment program will consist of a winter phase and summer phase with bulls weights being taken over 28 days during the development period. A June 4, 1994 Field Day is planned as the bulls will have completed the 140 day winter phase of the forage test.

An October 15, 1994 Sale in Brenham, Texas is also planned and each bull will sell with complete performance information to include: Adjusted 205 day weaning weights, yearling weights, gain weights, weight per day of age, ratios, rib-eye measurements and scrotal circumference.

APRIL 22ND IS EARTH DAY

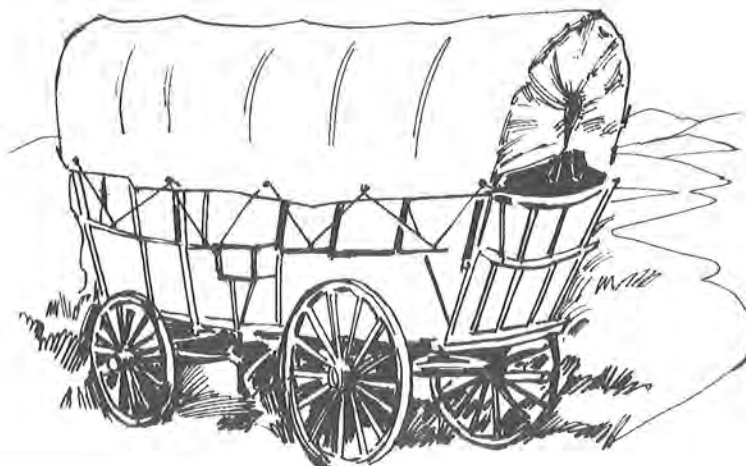

LAW PROTECTS BEEF'S IMAGE

The state of South Dakota has a new law permitting producer lawsuits against persons who maliciously disparage beef and other agricultural products. The measure, introduced by State Senator Mark Rogen on behalf of the South Dakota Cattlemen's Association, was recently passed by the state legislature and signed into law by Governor Walter Miller. It is directed at false claims that a product like beef is not safe for consumption or that gener-

ally accepted agricultural procedures make products unsafe. The law states that farmers, who have suffered damage as a result of disparaging statements about their product, have a right to sue. Any person who disparages a perishable agricultural food product with intent to harm the producer is liable for damages. The intent of the law is to prevent disparagement of the livestock industry and livestock products, the state association said.
