ISA CATTLE COMPANY'S 32ND BEEFMASTER BULL SALE

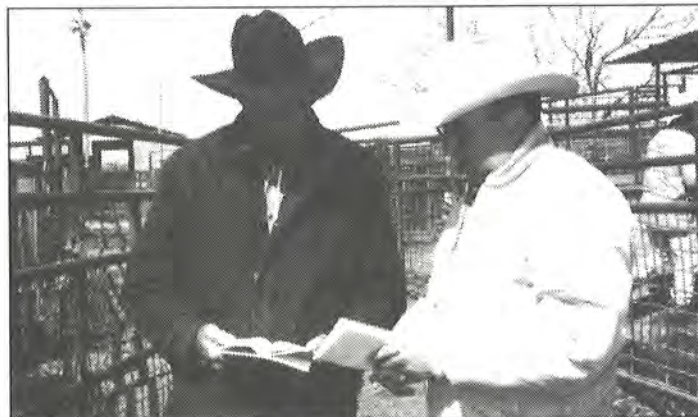
Isa Cattle Company's 32nd Beefmaster Bull Sale was held February 26 in San Angelo, Texas. The 217 bulls brought \$478,350 an average of \$2,204. This outstanding sale was one of the best in the company's history. The event, which featured buyers from six U.S. states and 3 states in Mexico, lasted two hours and thirty minutes.

The top-selling two-year-old bull raised by Denny Cattle Company sold to Bill Broussard of Melbourne, Florida for \$4,500. The top-selling long-yearling bull raised by Joe and Matt Brown of Eldorado, Texas sold to Rio Rancho Corporation of Okeechobee, Florida for \$3,500.

Volume buyers included the following: Sergio and Fernando Gonzalez - Hermosillo Sonora, Mexico - 45 bulls, \$105,700; Dick Jones Hebronville, Texas - 28 bulls, \$50,400; Barlite Ranch - Marfa, Texas - 20 bulls, \$44,900; Quinn Rivera Ranch - Denial, Nevada - 16 bulls, \$37,200; Rio Rancho - Okeechobee, Florida - 14 bulls, \$36,900; Promotora Agropecuaria San Ramon - Hermosillo, Mexico - 13 bulls, \$28,800; Stone Brothers - Raymondville, Texas - 11 bulls, \$25,400; Fritz Stein Farm - Avon Park Florida - 10 bulls, \$17,800; Franco Armendariz - Camargo, Chihuahua, Mexico - 6 bulls, \$11,800; Jay Garvin - Ft. Stockton, Texas - 6 bulls,

\$11,800; Baugh Family Ranch - Rotan, Texas - 6 bulls \$10,750; Two Cheeks Cattle Co. - Red Bluff, California - 3 bulls \$10,100.

In addition to the very successful bull sale, Laurie Lasater, President of Isa Cattle Co., secured a contract with Promotora Agropecuaria for \$729,500 of FBA-certified Beefmaster females which will be shipped to Sonora, Mexico

Dear Mary & all FBA members,

On Jan. 28 & 29, I had the privilege of staffing the Heart of America Beefmaster Breeders' booth at the Midland Empire Ag Show in St. Joseph, Missouri. The display included a variety of FBA literature, FBA Yearbooks, HOA members' business cards, and the Plan for Profit video. After seeing the reaction of about 15,000 passers-by, I can only praise the professional quality and attest to the effectiveness of FBA promotional material.

The video gathered crowds, and many visitors questioned me extensively about Beefmasters. Visitors took all of the 160 complete packets we'd bagged up, and almost all of the individual pamphlets. Also, 22 people, mostly potential bull buyers, signed up to receive catalogs for our HOA sale April 9 at Mt. Vernon, Missouri.

I was even lucky enough to get some free radio air time when Lynn Watts, a disc jockey covering the event for 100.7 FM, asked if she could interview me live about Beefmasters. (Of course, it didn't hurt that Jay Truitt, Walter and Barbara's son, works for this station.)

Booth visitors included current, future, and former owners of Beefmasters. Naturally, the questions from future owners centered on cold tolerance (we've been below zero often this winter) carcass quality, and especially disposition. The most common praise from current and former owners came for growth rate, milk production, disease resistance, and palatability. However, not all comments were favorable. A few former owners complained of disposition problems, pendulous sheath problems, and price discounts for Brahma-cross feeder cattle.

The praise was fun to hear, but it was by listening to the few complaints that I gained a greater appreciation of the FBA for having the foresight to link the breeder to his or her cattle, and to recognize that a given breeder's cattle will come to reflect a given breeder's preferences. I encouraged people to learn of Beefmasters as I have learned, by visiting many herds and getting to know many breeders, because cattle vary and guarantees are no better than the people who make them.

I thoroughly enjoyed working the booth and talking cattle with many people, some of whom have already visited my herd. After scratching my bull's head, hand-feeding a few cubes to my cows, and seeing the birth size of some new, first-cross calves, these people are now definitely in the market for Beefmaster bulls. It's rewarding to know that even as good as our promotional materials are, ultimately our cattle are even better at selling themselves.

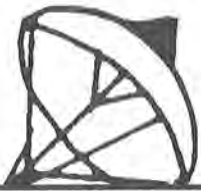

CTBB HOLDS ANNUAL MEETING

On February 5, we kicked off another year with our general membership meeting at Salado. The meeting was informative and enjoyable, with approximately 50 attending. The Friday evening gathering in President Steve McFaul's suite was great as usual. Our thanks go to Steve and Jean for hosting this get-together, as well as to Ron and Gary for bringing the food and drinks.

As noted in the attached minutes, it was decided to set the 1995 meeting a few weeks later as the early February date conflicts with many members' calving season. So mark your calendars for March 4, 1995, for the meeting at Fredericksburg. If you have never been to Fredericksburg, you are in for a treat. This old German town is in the Hill Country, with many unusual shops and interesting places to visit.

Also, mark your calendars for the field day at Clifton's on June 4. The date for the ranch tour at Grover Shade's and George Helmcamp's will be announced later. These events get better every year, and you're missing something if you don't attend.

We were sorry to hear of the deaths of members Lacy Dillard and George Sybert. Our sympathy also goes out to Gary and Terry Frenzel in the loss of their father on February 1.

A few good heifers (10-20) will be offered at this year's Brenham sale. They must be top end and bred to calve between December 15, 1994, and March 15, 1995. Last year the heifers sold reasonably well, averaging \$1,367. If you are

interested, contact me, Clifton or Gary. Any CTBB member can enter eligible females in the sale.

Clifton made a suggestion during the Directors' meeting that CTBB consign a pen of steers to the Ranch to Rail program. Although anyone can consign as few as five steers, it would be more instructive if there was an entire pen of CTBB Beefmasters on the program. This would require a carload (50,000 lbs. or 80 to 100 animals). This will be discussed in greater detail at a later date, but please give the idea some serious thought. We need to be most concerned with our end product—we should know where our breeding programs are leading.

The rain reports exchanged at the meeting were not too good. Most everyone reports below average rainfall for this time of year, and the winter grasses and grain are slow getting started. I had heard that rainfall in Clifton's country was short, but you couldn't tell it from the weight gains for the test bulls. They were weighed on Friday, February 4, and the average per day gain for the bulls was 3.31 lbs. for the first 28 days of the test. Clifton must be doing something right (that's not unusual for him.)

Let this letter serve as a reminder to pay your 1994 dues of \$35. According to the Bylaws, if dues are not paid by the end of March, membership is terminated. Make your check out to CTBB and send it to the undersigned.

10TH ANNUAL PANHANDLE-NEW MEXICO BEEFMASTER BREEDERS SATELLITE SEMINAR

The 10th Annual Panhandle-New Mexico Beefmaster Breeders satellite seminar was held on March 5 at Las Vegas, New Mexico's Civic Center. The weather cooperated nicely with sunny skies and warmth to entice approximately 80 people to turn out to view Beefmasters raised in the north east corner of New Mexico by Duree and Canadian River Beefmaster breeders, Charlie Duree and Joe Roy Ray. They also stayed to hear the Beefmaster story and enjoy the roast beef dinner catered at noon by the Hillcrest Restaurant of Las Vegas.

Gerry Holmes, national FBA president and Phyllis Sherriff of the national FBA office were present as well as several of the satellites Texas breeders. Gerry spoke to the crown on the Beefmaster traits and how they adapt to any climate and place comparing ranching in Alabama with New Mexico. He answered several questions from the floor at the end of his remarks. The video "Plan for Profit" was shown and well received.

Stuart Dixon, satellite member and board member of the Federal Land Bank in Texas, showed a very informative and disconcerting video of personal testimonies from individuals whose property has been seized by the federal government through the enforcement of environmental regulations. This video prompted an impromptu speech by Gabe Estrada, regulate his ranching operation on forest service permit acreage. Gabe shared much needed information concerning our right to know the rules and regulations these bureaucrats operate by. He stressed the need for each individual to get involved and learn these rights and use them to stop the bullying tactics used widely by government officials while invading our personal property rights to enforce environmental regulations.

Along with door prizes donated by area businesses, the satellite gave away five \$300 gift certificates good toward purchase of an animal at the 10th annual sale scheduled in Amarillo, Texas on March 26.

SOUTHERN BEEFMASTER BREEDERS BULL TEST UPDATE

After 118 days on grass Gowan 3/157 and WarEagle 9250 shared second highest weight per day of age rank of the 122 bulls on test. Both bulls had a USDA of 2.56 lbs.

Gowan 3/157 was also the high grieving Beefmaster posting 300 lbs. of gain on test. Wallace 316 ranked second with 285 lbs and War Eagle 9251 ranked third with 280 lbs.

22 Beefmaster bulls are consigned to the test from V&E Beefmasters Waynesboro, Miss; V&C Beefmasters, Montgomery, Ala.; Gowan Beefmasters, Montgomery, Ala.; Wallace Beefmasters, Magnolia, Miss.; and War Eagle Beefmasters, Opelika, Ala.

These bulls will sell in the South Mississippi Gain on Forage Test Sale, April 9, 1994 at the Livestock Sale

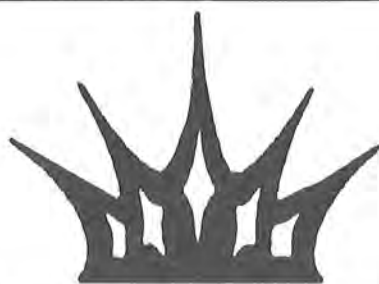

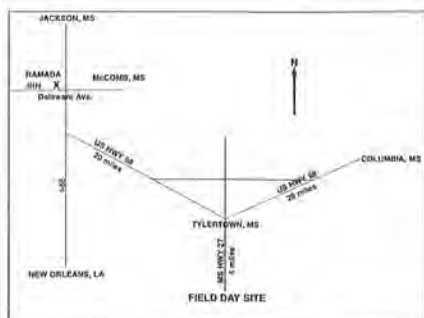

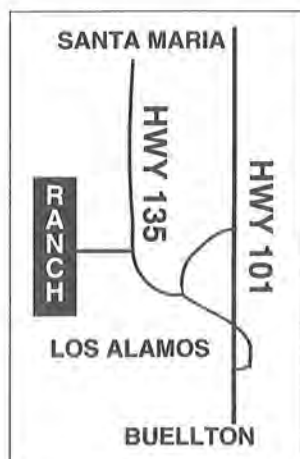
