## FOUNDATION FACTS

### Ward Burroughs, 1994 California Seedstock Producer

Ward Burroughs, along with his father Ernie and brother Bruce, operate Vista live stock and Dairy Company in the rolling foothills of northern Merced County. Today, Ward sells bulls from their Gelbvieh and Beefmaster herds; but it has not always been that way. My involvement with the Burroughs Family goes back over 20 years ago when the dairy was still located at Oakley, Bruce was managing the beef herd consisting of Holstein-Angus cross cows, and Ward was completing his degree at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo. Following graduation, Ward began managing the beef herd and also is also responsible for growing all the alfalfa hay and silage for the 1200 cow dairy which is consistently one the highest producing herds in Merced County.

The Burroughs family has a long history of cooperating in Cooperative Extension research and educational activities starting with Paul Lamborn in Contra Costa County and continuing with Don Petersen and Jim Farley in Merced County. Not only are they cooperators, but they are also strong supporters of Cooperative Extension and frequent users of our information and guidance.

During the fall and winter, the cows are pastured on annual clover-improved native pasture which surrounds the dairy and the ground which is farmed for the forage crops. The cows and their calves are moved to irrigated pasture in the delta in Contra Costa County in the spring where they stay until late summer. The cowherd is artificially inseminated, followed by a short exposure to cleanup bulls.

Performance records and performance testing have been a way of life for Vista Livestock Company. They utilized hand records until CowBoss became available; Ward Burroughs was one of the first producers in California to purchase CowBoss and put it into use in order to make management decisions. Ward has been conducting On-Ranch Bull Testing in cooperation with Cooperative Extension since 1989. The data provided to potential bull buyers includes performance in a 105 day gain test, semen evaluation, pelvic measurements, and sonogram information on fat thickness and ribeye area. Ward is very conscious of the disposition of his cattle, including the bulls he offers for sale. "Crazies," as he calls them go to slaughter; he doesn't want that trait in his herd and will not offer those kind of cattle to other people.

Ward is currently a Director of the Merced-Mariposa Cattlemen's Association. He and his wife, Rose, are the club leaders of their 4-H Club. Ward, along with the entire Burroughs family have been instrumental in establishing Valley Oak School in Turlock; a school specializing in the education of children with learning disabilities. They have four children, Christina, a sophomore in Animal Science at Cal Poly, Joe, a high school senior, Benina, a high school junior, and Zeb, a seventh grader.

Dear Mary

It concerns me that our association is losing income as the result of lowering the Certification Fee. As former treasurer of the FBA at the convention in San Antonio, Texas a few years back, this issue was addressed and as a result the fee was lowered to \$12.00 per animal. I was against this and stated as much, well it has finally caught up with us. We lost \$30,000.00 of income in 1994. It has been noted that it was passed to spend \$15,000.00 for a new video and another \$10,000.00 for a computer. This doesn't make sense to the mind of this member.

When Bill Broussard was FBA president a fund was established in the Merrill Lynch Gold Account for \$75,000.00. This was not to be touched unless authorized by four FBA officers. The \$30,000.00 was withdrawn properly for the loss of income stated above. There is now \$50,000.00 in this account. It is most likely that the video and computer cost will be taken from this account, keeping in mind FBA needs to make payroll and other expenses that are ongoing.

We cannot operate this way, if you operated your ranch in this manner how long would you last?

At the 1994 convention it was voted to lower the certification fee to \$10.00 per animal, even though FBA showed a loss of income for 1994, this doesn't make sense to me.

We as members and directors need to have the guts to stand up and come against things that hurt the FBA, the \$10.00 certification fee will not work as the \$12.00 fee did not work. The truth is in the financial records of FBA.

None of us have all the answers but working together we can come up with programs that are financially sound. The record in the past shows that breeders certify cattle when they sell them, it only makes sense, that's when they have the money.

## SOUTHERN BEEFMASTER BREEDERS BULL TEST UPDATE

Southern Beefmaster Breeders are utilizing the South Mississippi Forage Test for their official breed test again this year. Thirty top-end FBA bull calves were weighed in at the beginning of the test December 1, 1994. The bulls are currently being gain tested on Rustmaster ryegrass pasture and supplemented with minerals and crabgrass hay.

Approximately fifty percent of the bulls being tested will sell at 12:00 noon on April 8, 1995, at the Livestock Sale Facility on Highway 98, East, at Tylertown, MS. The 1995 sale will offer solid, pasture-conditioned, ready-for-service bulls.

Official data will include adjusted 205-day weights, 140-day gain on grass, sonogramed ribeye area, pelvic area, frame score, and scrotal circumference. All bulls will have a complete health program and will have passed a breeding soundness exam with-

in thirty days of the sale.

Consignors to the 1995 test and sale include Gerry Holmes, Hillview Beefmasters; Jim Gowan, Gowan Beefmasters; Jerry Shaw, War Eagle Beefmasters; Vander Walley, V & E Beefmasters; and Barry Wallace, Wallace Beefmasters.

## Fed-Cattle Prices Continue To Be Strong

The fed-cattle market surged last week to \$73-7the highest , price levels since late-April 1994. The market has been stronger than most predicted. According to Tom Brink, Cattle-Fax director of research, there

are several reasons for the higher prices. "The industry is extremely current and in a good bargaining position," says Brink. "The industry over-marketed cattle in November and December, which has flattened-out the winter bulge." Brinksays,

although beef-retail featuring in November and December was below the five-year average, beef-retail movement was good during that time period and after Jan. 1. How long will the black ink last for cattle feeders? "If the industry is current going into spring, a traditional time of tighter supplies, the black ink may continue for the first half of the year," Brink says.
